### Early Years Foundation Stage: 12 children at Hollycombe

### Key Stage Two Multiplication Tables Check for Year 4 children: 16 children at Hollycombe

The national curriculum expects all children to accurately recall the multiplication facts to 12 x 12 by the end of Year 4. Children who have mastered the times tables will be able to more effectively access Year 5 maths, such as further fractions work and more complex written calculations. Current Year 4s are the second cohort children to take this national online test. It consists of 25 random tables questions, each one to be answered within 6 seconds

There is no 'pass mark' for the check and individual school results are not published. Nationally, 25% of all Year 4 pupils achieved 25/25 in 2023. The mean score nationally in 2023 was 19.6: at Hollycombe 12 out of 16 children achieved 19 or better.
